**Directions:** Westry Hall Farm is situated about 15miles north of the Cambridge Machinery Saleground, 18miles east of Peterborough and 40miles north of Cambridge.

Heading from the Cheffins Cambridge Machinery Saleground head north on the A142 through Mepal towards Chatteris. At the Chatteris roundabout take the fourth Exit and continue on the A142 towards Wimblington / March. Follow the road to March and then at the next roundabout take the second exit to continue on the A141 / Wisbech road. In about 0.7miles the farm entrance will be on the right-hand side.

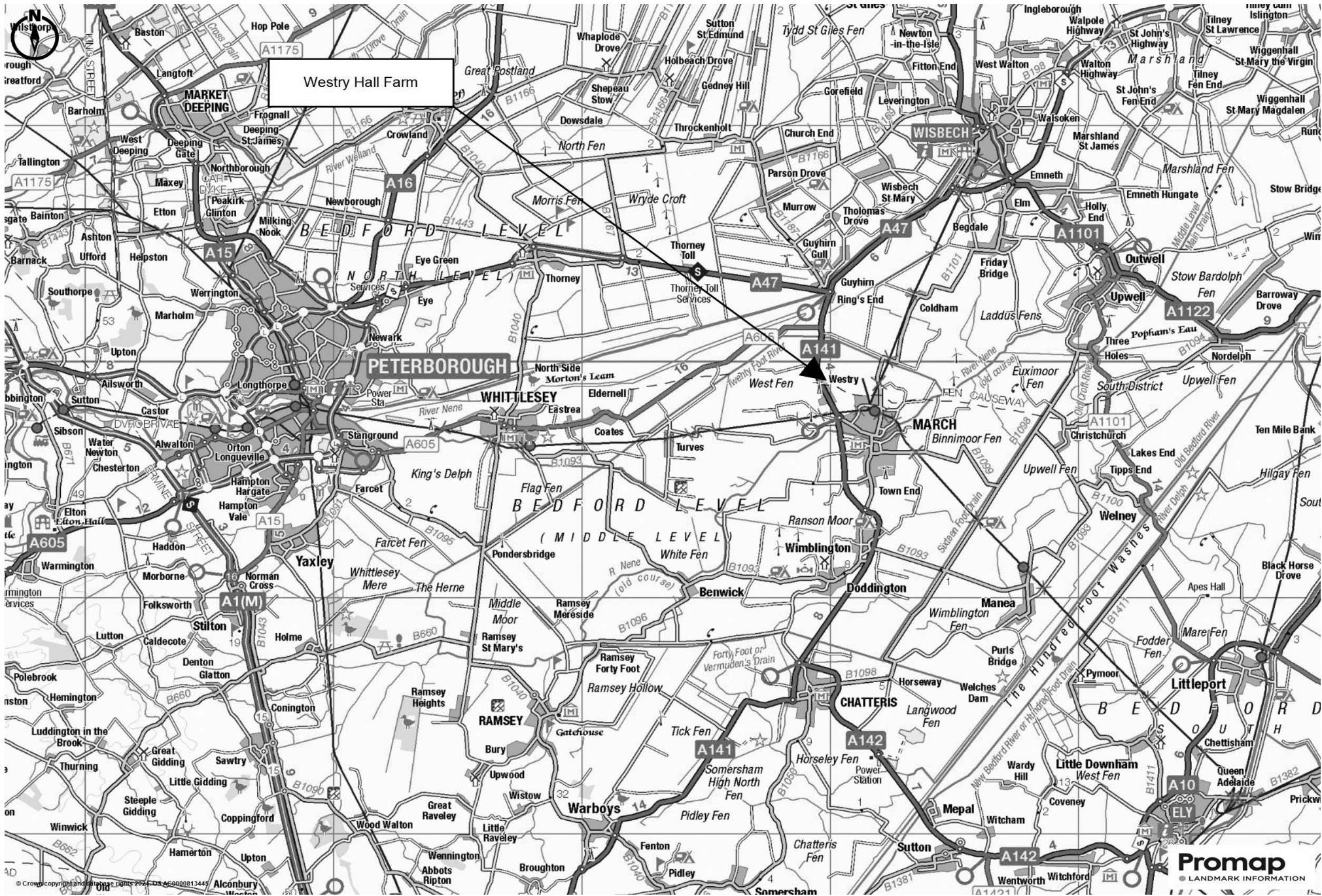

All Bidders and Buyers will be deemed to have read and accepted these terms and conditions prior to bidding. Our staff will be happy to help you if there is anything you do not fully understand.
- 1.2 Please refer to Clause 1 of the Conditions of Sale if you are unsure about the meaning of any defined term.
- 1.3 Except where the context otherwise requires words denoting the singular include the plural and vice versa. Words denoting one gender include all genders and words denoting persons include corporations and vice versa.
- 1.4 The Auctioneers may supplement or supersede these Conditions in whole or part with Special Conditions applicable to a specific sale or Lot which will be announced at the time of sale. No employee or agent of the Auctioneers has any authority to vary these Conditions.

### 2. Buyers Premium

- 2.1 All purchases will be subject to 3.5% buyer's premium on all Lots sold by auction or by private treaty:  
The Buyer's Premium will be subject to a minimum charge of £2.50 plus VAT per Lot and to the Conditions below.
